Executive branch agencies are working to address this issue by developing paid internship programs that provide students with valuable work experience, an expanded professional network and a better understanding of the impact of public service.

The Future Leaders in Public Service Internship Program supports this critical work. Managed by the Partnership for Public Service, the program offers students the opportunity to apply their educational training to federal service and brings diverse young talent into government. Undergraduate, graduate and professional students from across all academic disciplines are welcome to apply.

Established in 1977 to honor the memory of Harold Rosenthal, a Senate staff member who was a victim of a terrorist act while on official duty at age 29, the Rosenthal Fellowship is a prestigious program that offers our country's most outstanding and civic-minded graduate students in international affairs the opportunity to intern at a congressional or executive branch office for the summer. Over the years, fellows have interned at the State Department, Office of the Secretary of Defense for Policy, and Executive Office of the President, working to solve some of our biggest national and global challenges.
