# **AGENCY PARTNERSHIPS - AI PLACEMENTS**

Since 2022, the <u>Future Leaders in Public Service Internship Program</u> has placed over 600 talented students in paid internships across government—empowering the next generation of public servants. Through this initiative, the <u>Partnership for Public Service</u> provides government placements, cohort support, orientation, professional development, and alumni engagement.

The Partnership seeks agency partners to host interns in Al-related internships at **no cost** for Summer 2026. Program operations are funded by external grant funding, and intern stipends are funded by participating university partners. For agency partners, the Partnership for Public Service provides the following as part of the program:

- Program recruitment
- Application management
- · Candidate eligibility review
- Intern supervisor training and resources
- Coordination with the agency on intern placements
- Intern onboarding support and orientation
- Professional development workshops
- Support for interns throughout entire program

#### WHO SHOULD PARTNER

Program partners may include local, state, or federal government agencies looking to provide highly skilled early career applicants with direct pathways to their career talent pipeline in the fields of AI, public interest technology, data science and public administration.

Partners do not have to be located in the D.C. area, and the Partnership will recruit a wide range of candidates, possibly in the region of agency partners.

### **SELECTED INTERNS WILL RECEIVE**

- 10 12 week internship at approximately 32 - 40 hours/week with a local, state, or federal government agency during summer 2026.
- Professional development sessions.
- Orientation and onboarding sessions.
- Access to an extensive alumni network.

#### **AGENCY REQUIREMENTS**



- Establish an memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Partnership and commit to hosting 10-30 interns for Summer 2026.
- Finalize a MOU by November 28, 2025.
- Participate in a Meet the Agencies webinar in early 2026.
- Review eligible applications and conduct intern interviews.
- Identify and match interns with supportive supervisors.
- Execute background check process, if required by agency.
- Issue computers, equipment, and other technology to interns.
- Coordinate internship information and placements with the Partnership.

## STUDENT APPLICATION CRITERIA



Students who apply to the Future Leaders program must satisfy the following eligibility requirements:


- Must be a U.S. citizen.
- Be actively enrolled in an accredited undergraduate or graduate program, including community college students and PhD candidates.
- Undergraduates must be a sophomore or rising sophomore at the time of the internships in Summer 2026.
- · Have at least a 2.5 GPA.
- Must successfully complete any background checks as required by agency partners.



### **SUMMER 2026 PROGRAM TIMELINE**







- January 2026: Applicants are notified of eligibility status. Eligible applicants will receive instructions on next steps.
- January March 2026: Review eligible applications and conduct intern interviews.
- April May 2026: Background check process begins.
- May 2026: Virtual Orientation.
- June 2026: Internship Begins.
- August 2026: End of internship.
