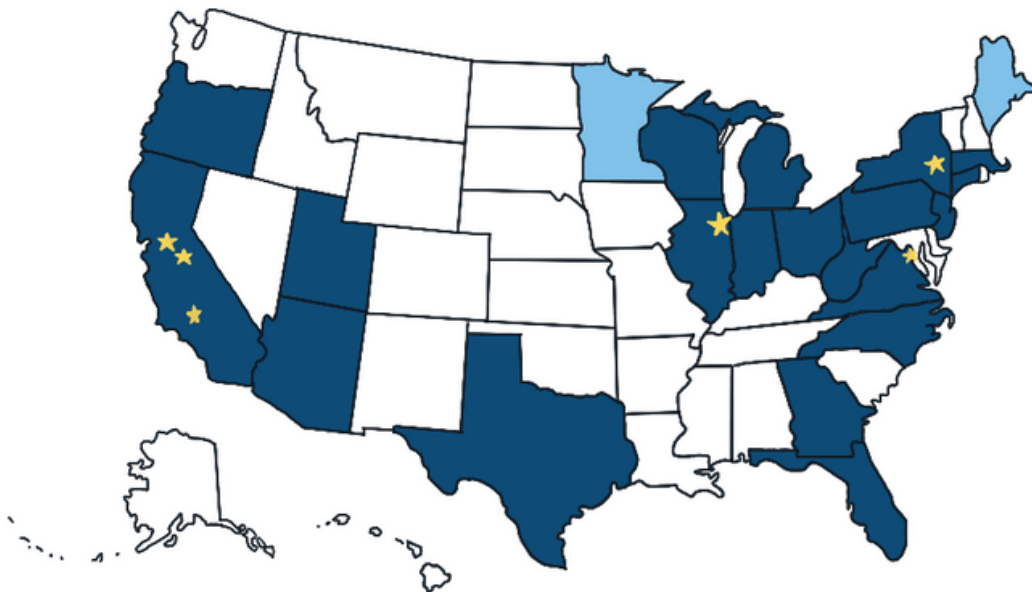

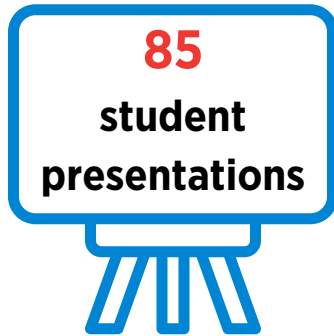

100% of advisors have a good understanding of the resources on federal hiring available to them through the Partnership

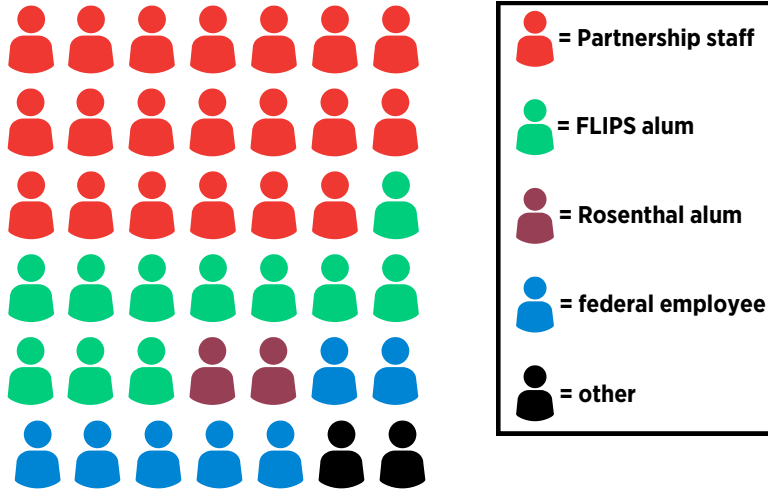

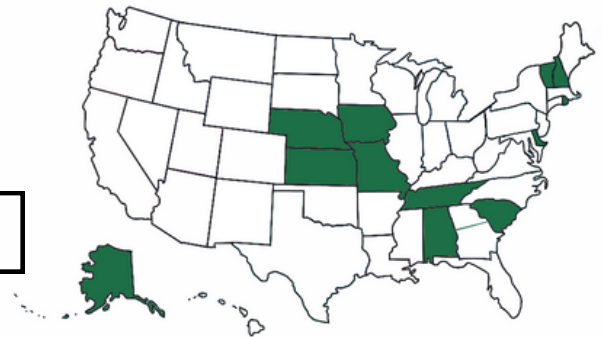
